The Cancer Treatment Center of Nice Antoine LACASSAGNE (CAL) announces the upcoming vacancy of the position of Head of the Translational Research Laboratory in Oncopharmacology of the hospital.

In close interaction with the Fundamental Research Institutes of Nice on the one hand and the clinical services of the Antoine Lacassagne Center on the other hand, the Head of the Translational Research Laboratory in Oncopharmacology of the CAL has the vocation to occupy the functions of Scientific Director of the establishment under the authority of the Director General of the Antoine LACASSAGNE Center.

Member of the Management Board, he is in charge of the definition and implementation of the scientific policy of the establishment and participates in the academic bodies in which he represents the Antoine Lacassagne Centre and its scientific policy.

He/she leads the translational oncopharmacology research laboratory with the support of a biologist in charge of the institution's clinical cancer biology activity.

He/she conducts finalized research in the fields of cancer biology, immunotherapies and drug treatments in cancerology.

Some of the laboratory's activities are experimental in nature, while the rest are aimed at developing clinical applications applicable to cancer treatment.

TRANSLATIONAL RESEARCH

The research project carried out by the Laboratory manager will reinforce the partnership developed between the Lacassagne Cancer Treatment Center in Nice and:

- the Institute for Research on Cancer and Aging (IRCAN), whose main theme is the common mechanisms between cancer and aging.
Translational research projects involving IRCAN teams will be privileged, in particular those hosted by the CAL, with a focus on lung, breast, head and neck carcinomas, renal carcinomas, sarcomas and gliomas as well as innovative targeted treatments (immunotherapy, radiotherapy /tontherapy, anti-angiogenesis, kinase inhibitors).
Good organization and expertise in pre-clinical and clinical trials as well as links with pharmaceutical companies will be crucial.
